Time commitment:

Assistant swim coach requirements:

- Must be 14+
- A minimum of three years of competitive swimming experience including regular attendance at meets with the Sharks or another swim club.
- Ability to explain, demonstrate and provide feedback during dryland activation.
- Comfortable communicating with athletes to provide technical feedback on strokes
- Reporting on deck to the head or lead coach and swim director

Aquatic certifications:

- Bronze Cross certification at minimum
- Current Standard First Aid, CPR-C (preferred)

Head and lead coach requirements:

- Effective organizational, leadership, supervisory and communication skills.
- Ability to implement competitive swim training programs.
- Ability to explain, demonstrate and provide feedback during dryland activation.
- Comfortable communicating with athletes to provide technical feedback on strokes.
- Mentor, educate, delegate to, and supervise, the assistant and volunteer coaches.
- Capable of using programs for communications such as Google Docs, G-drive

- Current Standard First Aid, CPR-C
- Current NL
- SFLI (preferred)
- NCCP 1+ or equivalent (preferred)

- Wages based on current certificates.
